LANCASTER MSA APRIL UNEMPLOYMENT RATE 3.5%

HARRISBURG (MAY 31) – The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the Lancaster Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) was down one-tenth of a percentage point over the month to 3.5 percent in April 2022. The statewide rate declined to 4.8 percent, while the national rate was unchanged at 3.6 percent.

Seasonally adjusted total nonfarm jobs in the Lancaster MSA decreased 0.4 percent over the month (-1,100) to 253,000 in April. Over the year, jobs were up 1.7 percent (+4,300) in the MSA as statewide jobs rose 3.7 percent over that time.

April's Not Seasonally Adjusted Nonfarm Jobs Detail

Over the month, five of the ten industry supersectors increased, while four were unchanged. Leisure & hospitality had a seasonal increase of 600 jobs in April. Over the year, nine of the ten supersectors added jobs with the largest increase in trade, transportation & utilities (+2,900).

FOOTNOTES

1/ Estimate of workers by place of residence. These data are controlled to state Current Population Survey (CPS) data which adjusts for commuting and dual job-holding.

Workers are counted where they live only once regardless of the number of jobs they may hold. All in-depth inquiries relative to the estimating methodology should be addressed to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor. All data are subject to revision during annual benchmarking.

2/ Includes wage and salary workers (including agriculture), self-employed persons, and unpaid family workers (including agriculture), domestic workers, and persons involved in labor-management disputes.

3/ Unemployed as percent of civilian labor force, computed using unrounded data.

4/ Seasonally adjusted MSA level data (and their equivalent) is developed by the federal Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS); seasonal adjustment for all other sub-state areas are developed by CWIA.
