

STEVENS AMENDMENT

The Stevens Amendment is an appropriations provision that requires grantees of the Department of Labor (DOL), Health and Human Services (HHS), and Education to disclose for a grant program the percent of the costs financed with federal funds.

I. PUBLIC LAW 101-166, SECTION 511

- Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) programs are federally supported 100% by the U.S. Department of Labor as part of an award totaling \$3,161,728.02 with \$0 (0%) state, local and/or non-governmental funds.
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) programs are federally supported 100% by the U.S. Department of Human Services as part of an award totaling \$2,677,361 with \$0 (0%) state, local, and/or non-governmental funds.
- ReEntry Employment Opportunities (REO) programs are federally supported 100% by the U.S. Department of Labor as part of an award totaling \$1,499,000 with \$0 (0%) state, local, and/or non-governmental funds.
- Discretionary grants are federally supported 100% by the U.S. Department of Labor as part of an award totaling \$682,180.57 with \$0 (0%) state, local and/or non-governmental funds.
- American Builds Apprenticeship is federally supported 100% by the U.S. Department of Labor as part of an award totalling \$183,333 with \$0 (0%) state, local and/or non-governmental funds.
